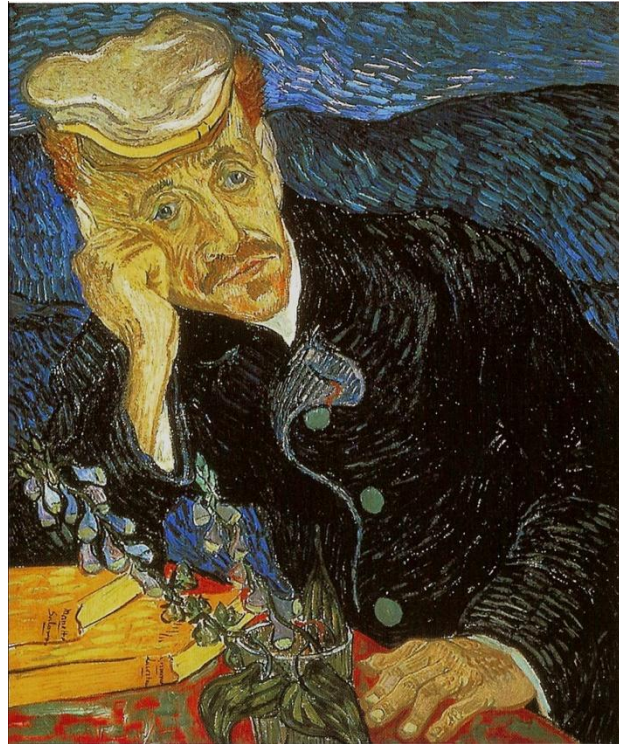

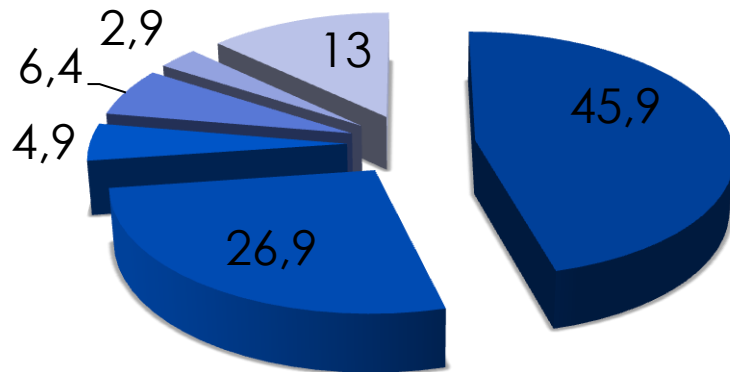

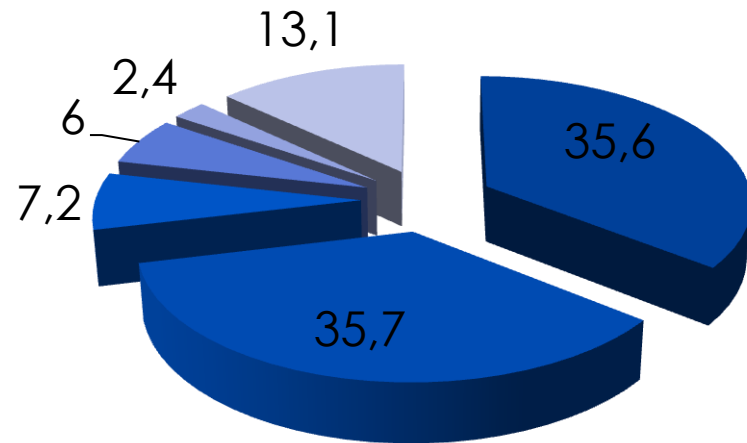
Kunstauktionen nach Ländern: Umsätze in %

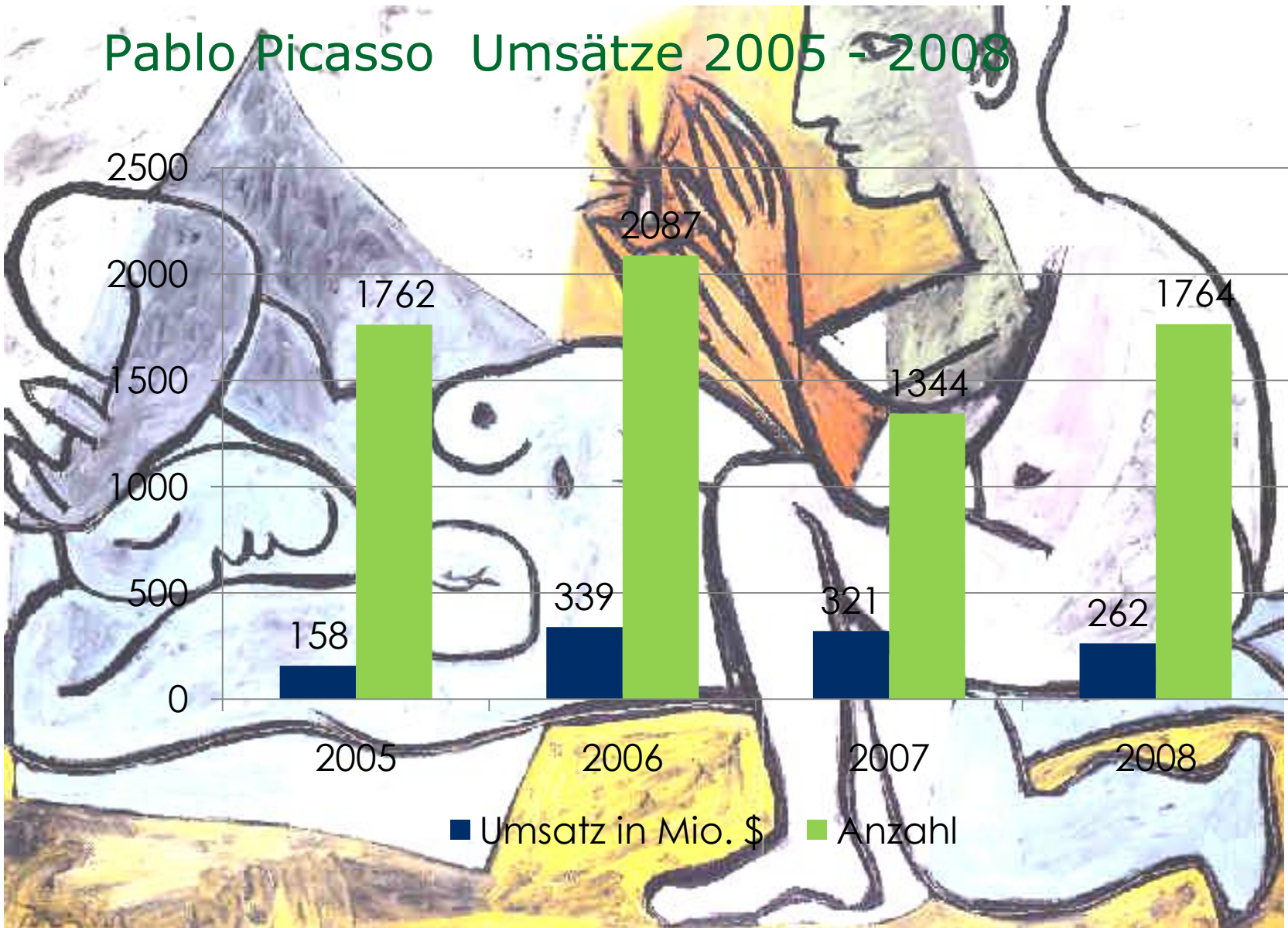

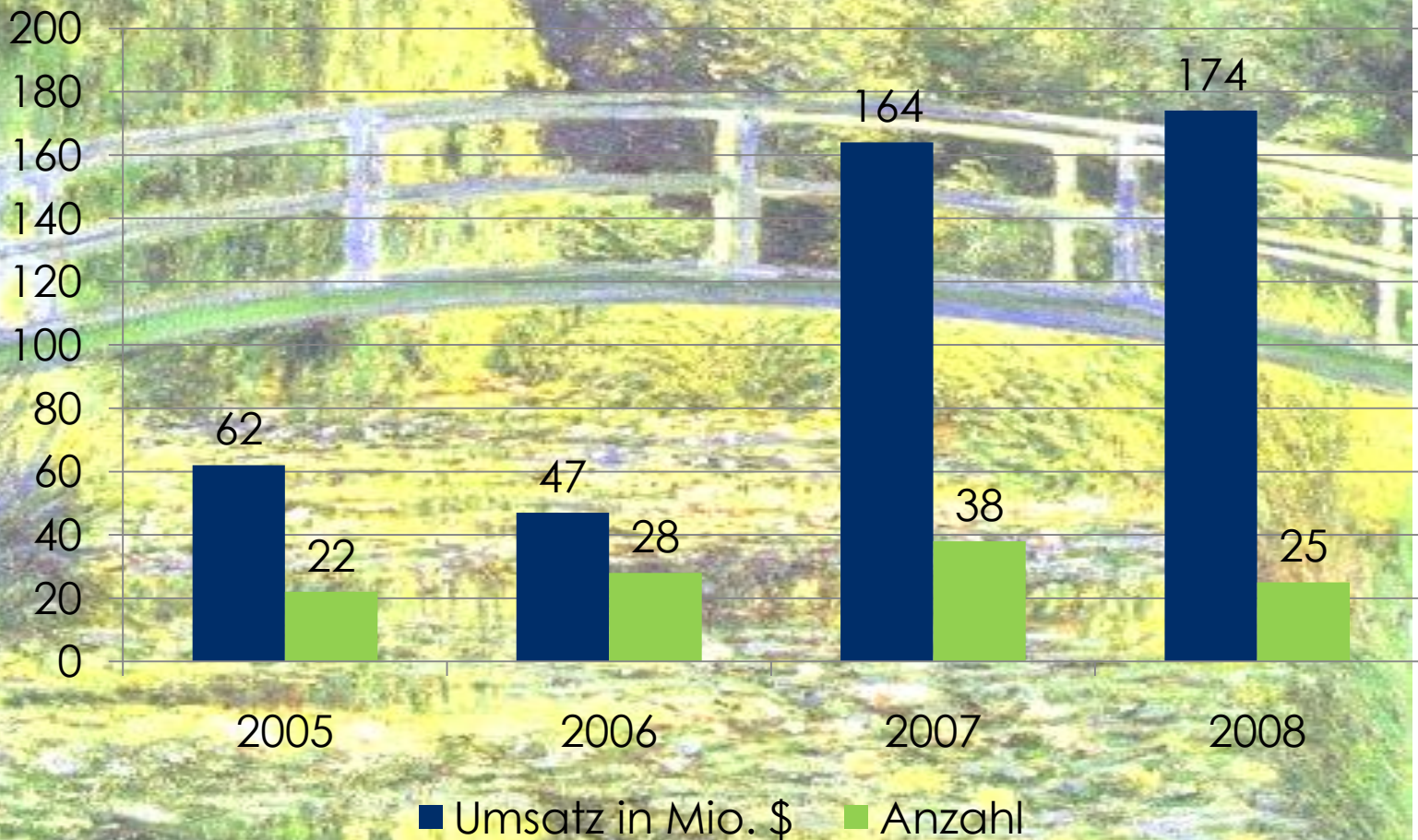
Pablo Picasso Umsätze 2005 - 2008



Francis Bacon Umsätze 2005 - 2008

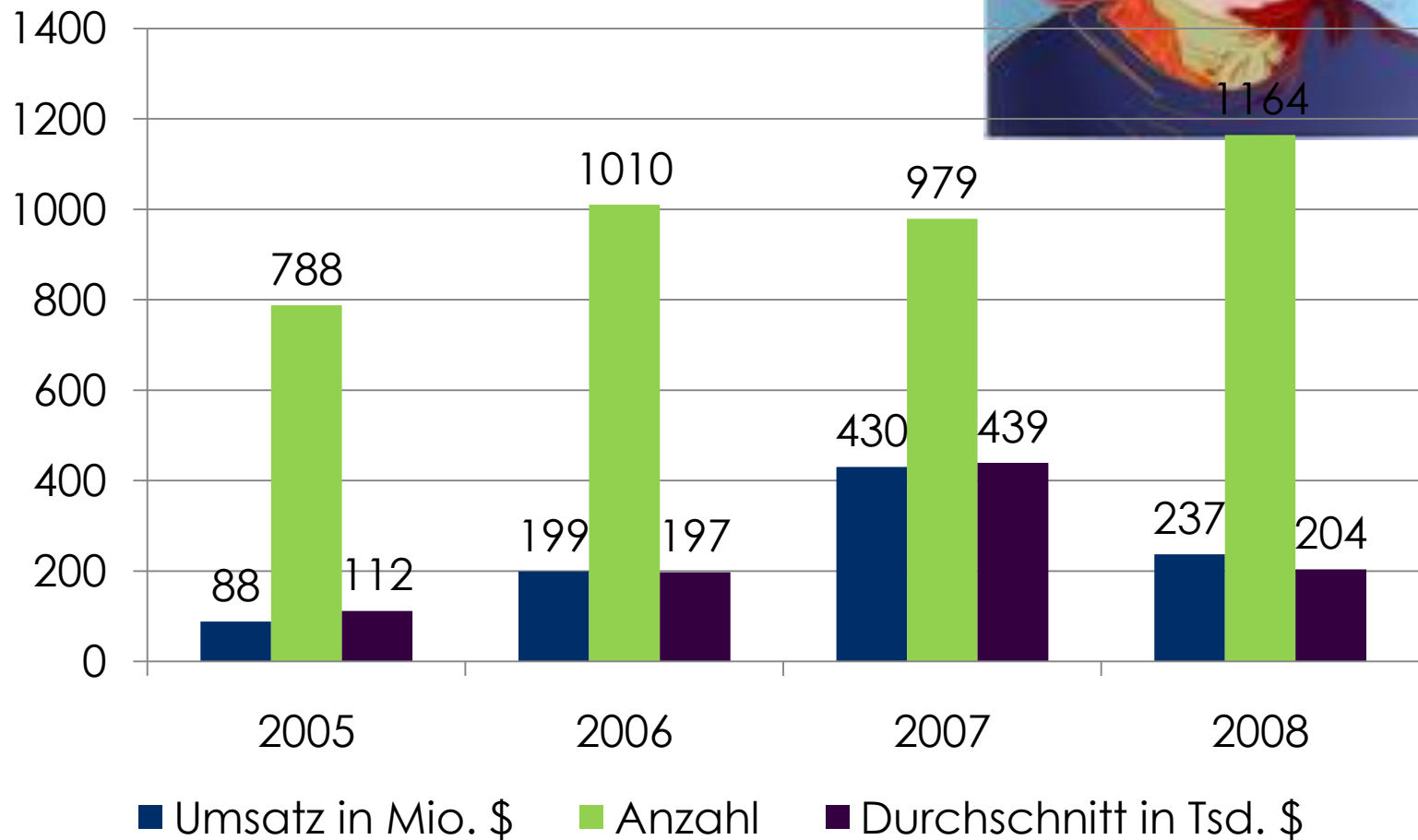


Claude Monet Umsätze 2005 - 2008

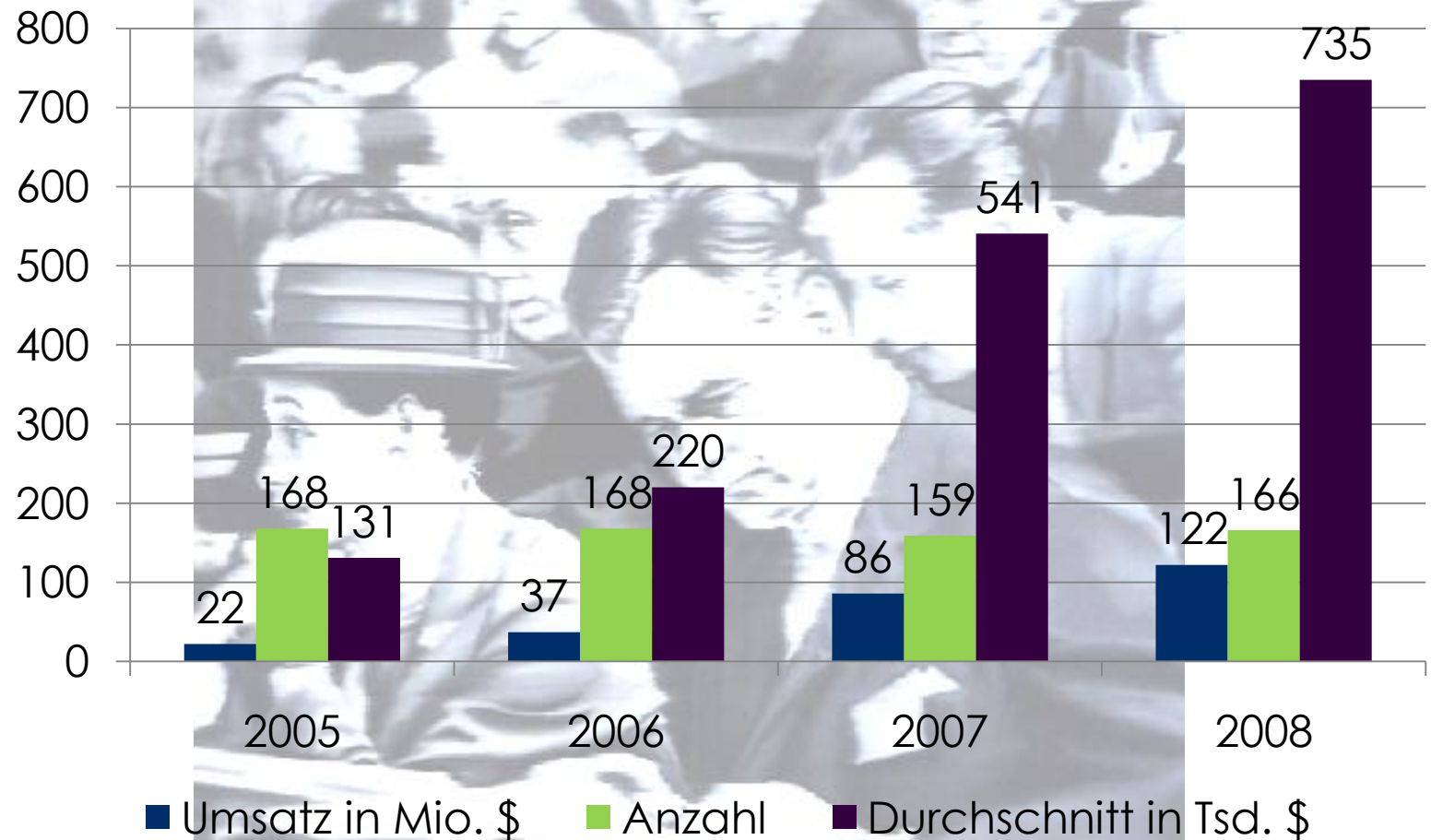




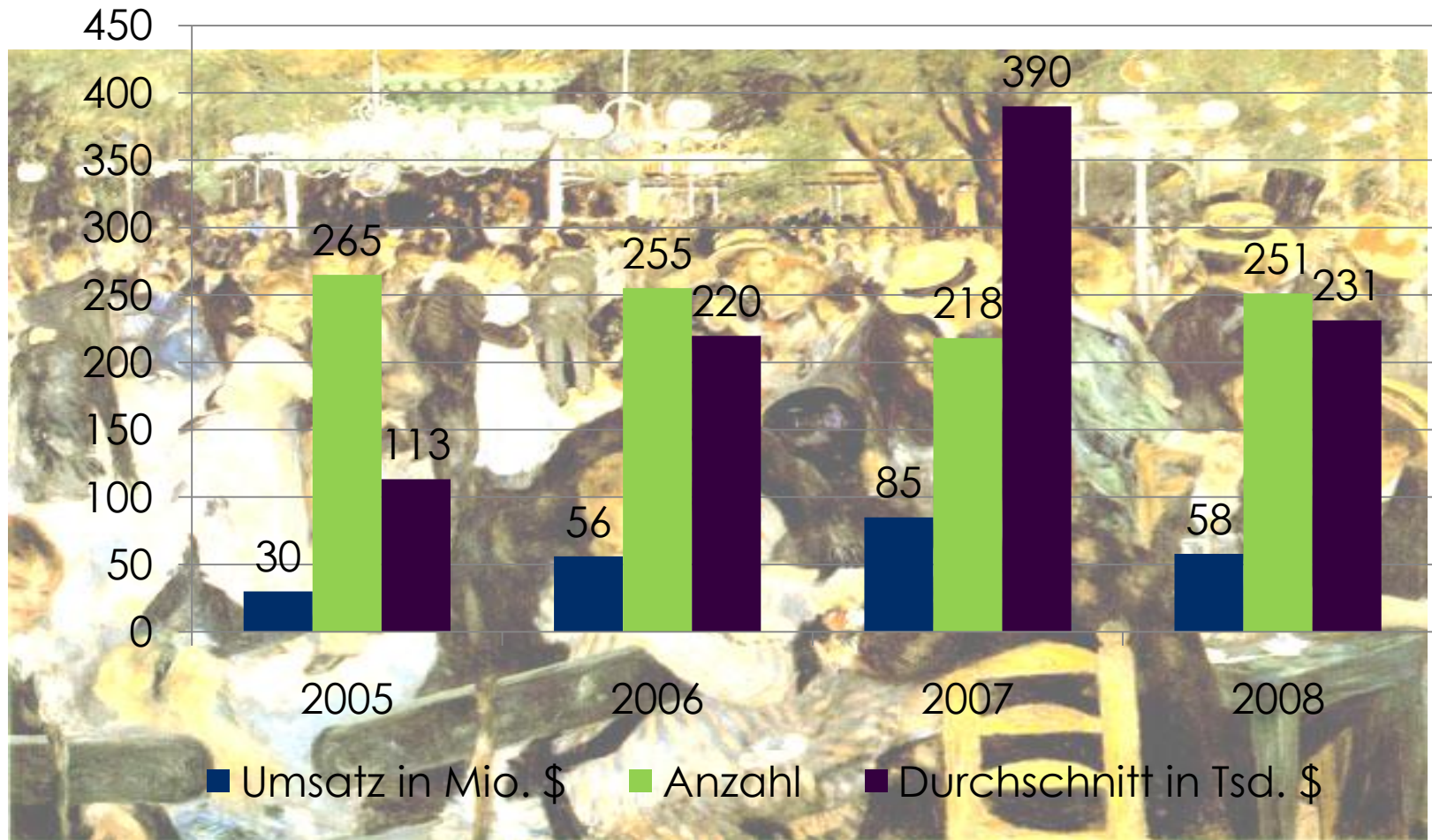
Andy Warhol Umsätze 2005 - 2008



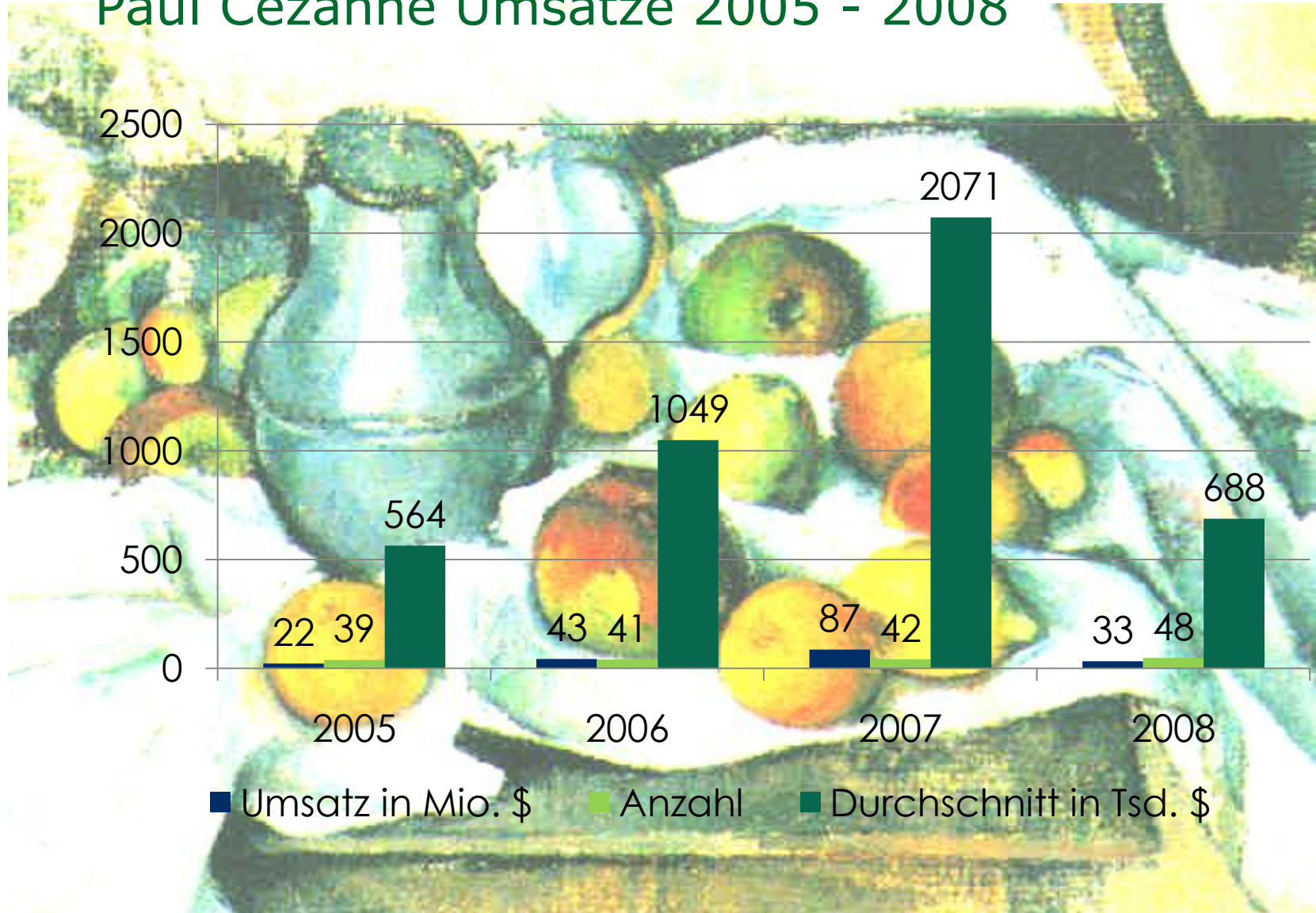
Gerhard Richter Umsätze 2005 - 2008



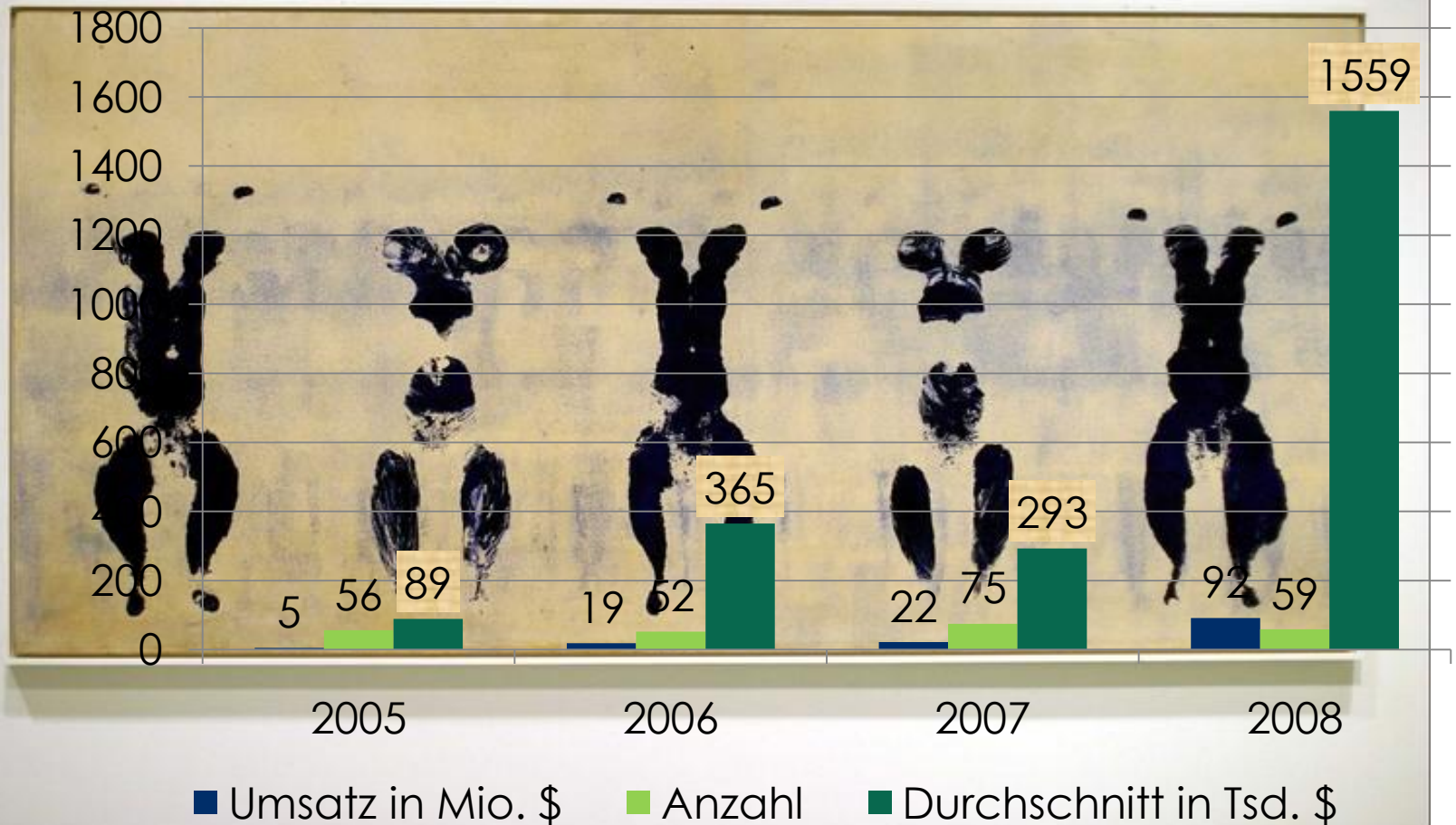
Auguste Renoir Umsätze 2005 - 2008

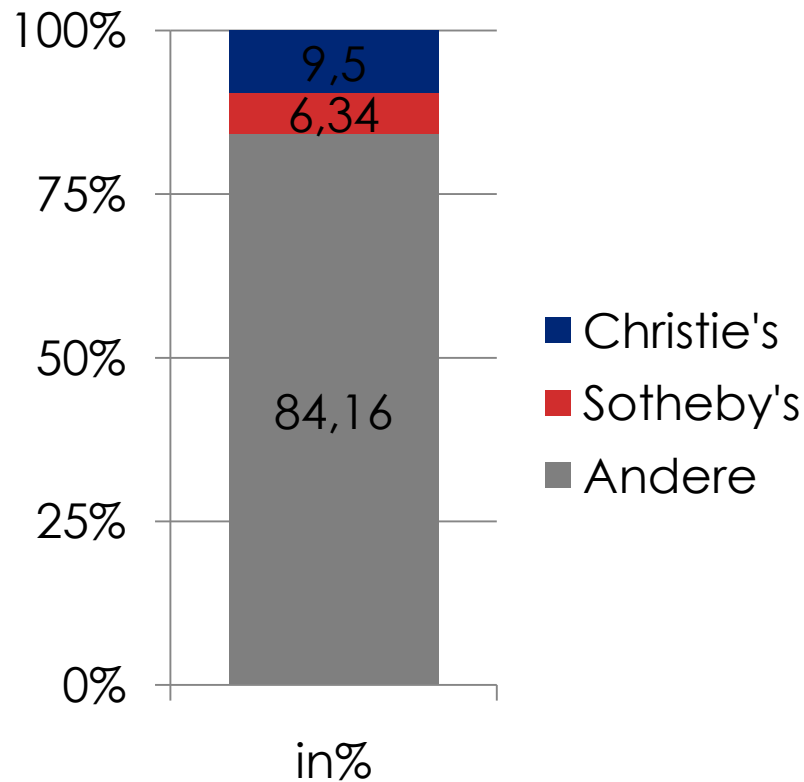

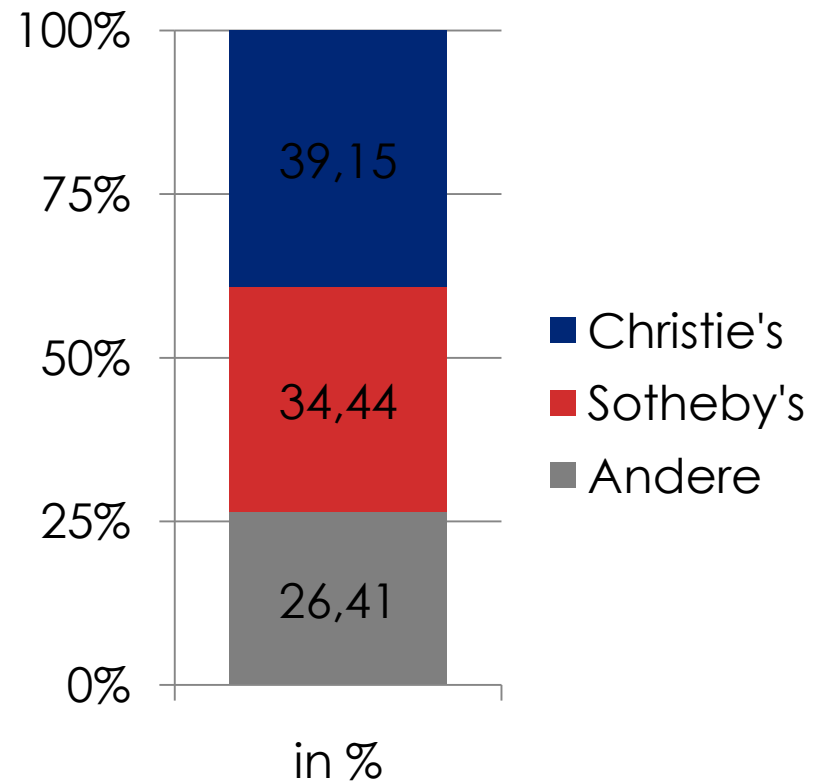

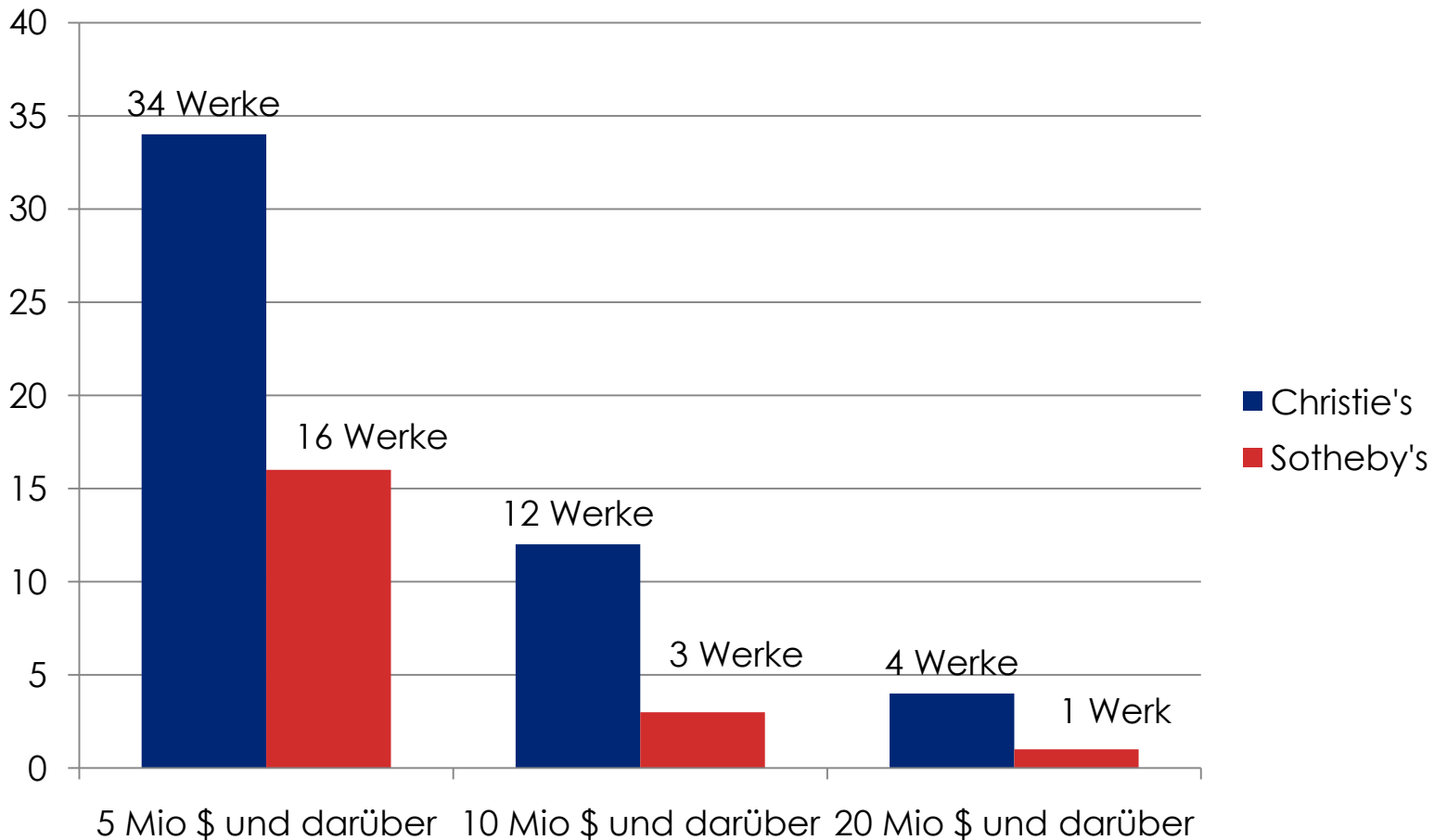
Anzahl der Einzelobjekte



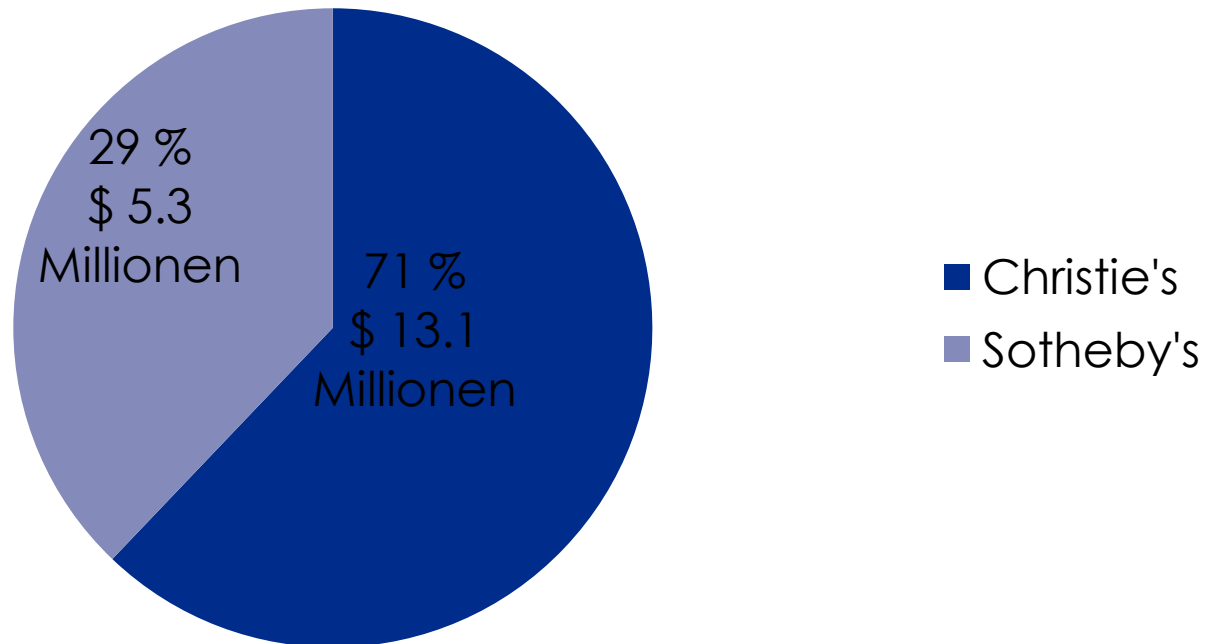
Anteil am Auktionsumsatz
